Dear Friends of Maison Chance,

The year 2019 has just ended, and it has been a memorable year for Maison Chance thanks to the completion of the Maison Chance Social Center in Dak Nong Province.

This project grew out of the need to cater for the most disabled and aging beneficiaries who do not manage to reintegrate sociably. In parallel, the new center also takes care of children with multiple disabilities, orphans and poor children of ethnic minorities from the province.

The project started in 2012, and 7 years later, a beautiful center emerged, comprising nearly 30 buildings and infrastructures erected on a 27,000 square meters field. Its opening was celebrated on 14th December 2019. The investment cost of construction and equipment of this center is about 2,100,000 USD. During August 2019, we have welcomed 45 new beneficiaries, adding to the 120 children who arrived one year before.


For the year 2019, the functioning cost of the 3 centers in Saigon and the center in Dak Nong is more than 800,000 USD. In 2020 we will welcome 20 additional beneficiaries in Dak Nong. Vocational training workshops will also be implemented. The budget for 2020 will increase to more than 900,000 USD. Every year myself and my team work incessantly to try to raise this money and it's work that is never ending. We constantly run low on funds and it's only thanks to the kind generosity of people like yourself that keeps Maison Chance afloat and allows us to bless the underprivileged people of Vietnam.

On behalf of all Maison Chance beneficiaries, I would like to express you my most sincere and heartfelt thanks and wish you all the very best for this new year full of joy, health, happiness, chance and success, at all levels.


REPORT ON DAK NONG

After the ceremony of opening, the guests visited the rooms of children, the classrooms, the gardens and the medical rooms... They have also taken some time to speak with the children and people with reduced mobility to gain insight on their life at the center.









SOLIDARITY TOURISM AT MAISON CHANCE DAK NONG

The Maison Chance Social Center in Dak Nong is the fourth unit of Maison Chance established in favor of disabled people, orphans, and unprivileged children who receive accommodation, medical care, primary education and vocational education freely. Located about 350 km north of Ho Chi Minh City, the center is served by buses and an airport 44 km away from the center. The climate in Dak Nong Province is mild thanks to its average altitude being 600m above the sea level. The province is also well known for its

waterfalls, nature reserves and cultural diversity thanks to the ethnical minorities inhabiting the region. As a matter of fact, the center is next to Dray Sap - Dray Nur - Gia Long, a nature reserve famous for its impressive waterfalls. These assets enable Maison Chance to offer its tourism services. Since its opening in 2018, the Social Center has welcomed visitors who come to experience the life in the center and to visit the beneficiaries. They can be housed in our guesthouses that have a capacity to receive 44 people.







In addition, all infrastructures and equipment are adapted for people with disabilities. The restaurant offers traditional Asian and Western cuisine and the outdoor swimming pool can be enjoyed by our guests and beneficiaries.

During their stay, visitors can interact with the pupils and disabled people of the center. Furthermore, they can take part in our daily life activities such as planting fruit trees and taking care of the organic farm and animals.



Our center is surrounded by the most stunning nature and guests can enjoy several activities nearby. These activities include - visiting the stunning waterfalls, taking a bath with elephants, biking, kayaking or taking a basket boat (traditional Vietnamese boat) on the river. Our tours are suitable for both individuals and groups. One of the benefits of being a visitor is that it allows you to have a better understanding of the beneficiaries' life and to be more aware of the volunteering values within the community. Beneficiaries also benefit by having guests here as they get to interact with visitors which helps them with their social intergration.
