

Maison Chance is a non-governmental organization operating in Vietnam. We provide housing, medical care, education and vocational training for orphans, street children and people with disabilities. Our goal is to help these less fortunate people regain their autonomy and give them the opportunity to reintegrate into society.

Maison Chance Vietnam has four sites: Maison Chance Shelter, Take Wing Center, Chance Village in Ho Chi Minh City and Maison Chance Social Center in Dak Nong province.

MAISON CHANCE IN HO CHI MINH CITY

BENEFICIARIES

In 2018, Maison Chance in Ho Chi Minh City helped <u>580</u> people.



MAISON CHANCE SHELTER

Includes 27 people with disabilities and 10 orphans. In the first six months of 2018, two members were integrated into society and we received 6 new members.



VILLAGE CHANCE

Disadvantaged children and adolescents living in surrounding areas; children of beneficiaries are provided with free education.

TAKE WING CENTER

People with disabilities in difficult circumstances and their relatives are supported with vocational training and job hunting.




EXTERNAL BENEFICIARIES

Includes poor children, people with disabilities and former beneficiaries. Maison Chance provides them with health care services, medicine, tuition, food and financial support, and helps them get into schools, vocational training centers and find jobs.



PERSONNEL

Maison Chance had 101 staff working in three sites in Ho Chi Minh City in 2018, including 65 permanent employees, 14 temporary employees (working part time or short time), ten Vietnamese volunteers and 12 international volunteers.



VOLUNTEERS

Vietnamese volunteers

There are 10 people working in different fields:

- Education & Training: 5 Taekwondo trainers and computer technology teachers for children; 1 computer technology teacher for members with disabilities.
- Healthcare: 4 volunteer doctors specializing in urology, spine and dentistry. These doctors have cooperated with Maison Chance for many years.

International volunteers


There are 12 volunteers from France, Switzerland, Poland, Canada, USA, Australia working in physical therapy, dentistry, special needs education, social work, agriculture, infrastructure repair.


Achievements

At the end of the school year, there were 177 students from grades 1 to 5 taking the end-of-school test; the results were as follows:

- 88/177 (49.7%) students were rated Good for their performance and moral training.
- Math: 111/177 students with 9 and 10 points (accounting for 62.7%) and only 1 student below 5 points.
- Vietnamese: 83 students with 9 and 10 points (47%); and only 1 student below 5 points.
- Grade 5: 33/33 students completed the primary school program, 6 students achieved 20/20 points in Math and Vietnamese at the final exams.
- **Reward:** 76 students were rewarded for their academic performance and learning efforts, representing 43%.

Kindergarten

- There are 39 children (16 girls, 23 boys) aged of 1 to 6 in kindergarten. Classes are from Monday to Saturday (7am to 5pm). Here, the children are provided with three meals a day (breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack).
- The health of children is monitored in accordance with the Ministry of Health requirements (monthly weight monitoring and periodic deworming). All babies are healthy.

The children are divided into 2 different age groups


- The first group is between 6 months and 3 years old. The main activities of the kids are mainly learning and exploring games.
- The second group is between 3 years and 6 years old. Children are equipped with knowledge to prepare for primary school, including writing, reading and math.

Volunteers at the kindergarten come to play and teach English and songs to children.

Curriculum

Children learn topics such as Tet - the Vietnamese New Year - and Spring, plants, traffic safety, their country, school... They are also taught soft skills like self-service, self-protection and interpersonal skills.



VOCATIONAL TRAINING & PRODUCTION

About 60 people with disabilities and young people in difficult circumstances are receiving vocational training and working in five different workshops at the Take Wing Center and Chance Village.

They will be paid according to the characteristics of each job. Working beneficiaries receive 30% of their salary directly and the remaining 70% will be saved in their own accounts. All these savings will be returned when they integrate into society. Thus, they will have a small capital when they start their independent life.



Sewing workshop: 21 members at the sewing workshop learn to make and produce stuffed animals, puppets and fabric products such as handbags, keychains, stars, hearts, student clothes, T-shirts, backpacks and souvenirs. The production is according to customer's orders. In 2018, the total number of fabric products made is 22191 items.

Drawing workshop: There are 6 apprentices learning and practicing oil painting techniques and reproductions. They draw small landscape pictures, design Tet cards and paintings according to customer's orders. The total number of products made in 2018 was 1012 items.

IT workshop: There are 15 apprentices following the training program on basic information technology, SEO, web programming and website management. They provide these services to individuals and companies.

Bakery workshop: 4 apprentices are trained to make ice cream and baked goods such as basic bread, sandwiches, and pastries.

Precious stone treatment workshop: Starting operations in October 2016, 8 apprentices learnt basic gemstone treatment. They have completed the 6-month training of polishing. At the same time, they began to learn basic carving. Now they are able to make statues such as the 12 zodiac animals. After this stage, they will continue to improve their carving ability to make sophisticated products such as buddha statues and small jewels. Recently, the workshop has made stone watches with wooden frames for Maison Chance to give its benefactors on the occasion of Lunar New Year holidays.



MEDICAL CARE DEPARTMENT







Physiotherapy

Organize daily physiotherapy sessions to reduce pain, maintain muscles and joints of people with disabilities. Organize aqua-therapy exercises at the Village Chance for people with disabilities. Aquatic exercises are good for them even

Aqua-therapy

Organize aqua-therapy exercises at the Village Chance for people with disabilities. Aquatic exercises are good for them even with the most severe cases. Underwater weightlessness reduces pressure on the back and joints as well as relieves stressful sensations for patients. The water temperature in the pool is always kept warm.

Dentistry

There are volunteer dentists who come to examine and provide treatment free of charge. In 2018, 34 check-up sessions were given to 196 patients.

In 2018, 73 beneficiaries went to a hospital for checkup and 8 were hospitalized for bladder and ulcer infections. In this year, the Health Department has completed procedures and purchased health insurance for 53 people.



ADMINISTRATIVE DEPARTMENT

The duty of the Administrative Department is to organize and manage the daily activities of Maison Chance in Vietnam.

In 2018, the Administrative Department completed the following tasks:

- Visit governmental organization on the occasion of the Lunar New Year.
- Contact local police to make a temporary residence registration for members with disabilities at Maison Chance and Village Chance.
- Welcome the Binh Tan District Fire Protection Inspectors to check and complete the fire protection management documents.
- Apply for temporary residence and related procedures for foreign volunteers to work at the Centers.
- Prepare documents and welcome inspectors from Binh Tan District Labor Office. Maison Chance was evaluated well in all activities.







GOODS & EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT

The main duty of the Goods & Equipment Department is to maintain the three centers of Maison Chance in HCM city. In addition to regular equipment repair and maintenance, the Department has performed the following tasks:

- Inventorying of all facilities at 3 centers.
- Repairing and maintaining all wheelchairs and electric wheelchairs for disabled members.
- Installing water system connected to city water mains.
- Setting up equipment for Stone Treatment workshop.
- Maintaining generators of the 3 centers, dredging manholes and sewer lines at Take Wing Center and Village Chance.
- Installing kitchen smoke exhaust system at Take Wing Center.
- At Village Chance: Maintaining and repairing the solar power system; Waterproofing of the school terrace and WC; Periodically repairing and maintaining elevators; Installing domestic water filtration system for apartments; Repairing the swimming pool including replacing of the water filtration system and tiling the peeled areas in the walls and at the bottom of the pool.

To date, the following items have been completed and approved by the authorities to be put into use, including:

Fence gateways; Security office; Vocational training workshops; Showroom & Cafeteria; Infirmary - physiotherapy; Horse yard for equine therapy; 5 classrooms; Teachers' room; Multipurpose room; Canteen and kitchen; House for volunteers; 2 beneficiary houses; Shared toilets; Water tower & underground water tank; Heart-shaped Lake; Water regulation pond; Farm warehouse; Breeding facilities; Fire protection system; Internal road system; Water supply; Outdoor lighting power and Active lightning protection system.





On-going building projects

- **2-storey blocks for beneficiaries:** The structural work has been completed, and the finishing is starting.
- Guest house: Start building the foundation and surrounding walls.
- Swimming pool: Finish the foundation, the bottom and the walls of the pool.
- Dressing room for the pool: Finish the foundation and start building the walls.
- Wastewater treatment system: Finish and start testing the system.
- Internal roads around agricultural areas: Finish.
- Agricultural area: Improve soil and start planting vegetables.





STUDENTS


In August 2018, the center was put into operation with the coming of the first 116 primary students. School year 2018 - 2019 started on September 5 with four classes from grade 1 to grade 4 and a special needs class. Grade 5 will be opened in 2019. Most children are ethnic minorities. They follow the national curriculum of the Ministry of Education and stay at the center. 17 children with physical or intellectual disabilities receive daily health care and attend special needs classes.





PERSONNEL

In 2018, Maison Chance Social Center in Dak Nong recruited 38 employees.



In 2018, Maison Chance Vietnam received a total of US\$1,720,676 from domestic and intenational organizations, associations, companies and individuals and from its business activities. Maison Chance Vietnam spent US\$1,542,576 to cover construction costs at the Social Security Center in Dak Nong, investment costs, operating costs and other costs of all social centers.

The operating cost of the Project Office was US\$66,738, accounting for 4.3% of the total cost of Maison Chance Vietnam in 2018.





CONCLUSION

2018 marks the 25-year journey of Maison Chance's presence in Vietnam to bring a better future for the most unfortunate people, especially for abandoned children, orphans and people with disabilities.
